



# Anatomy of a Flower

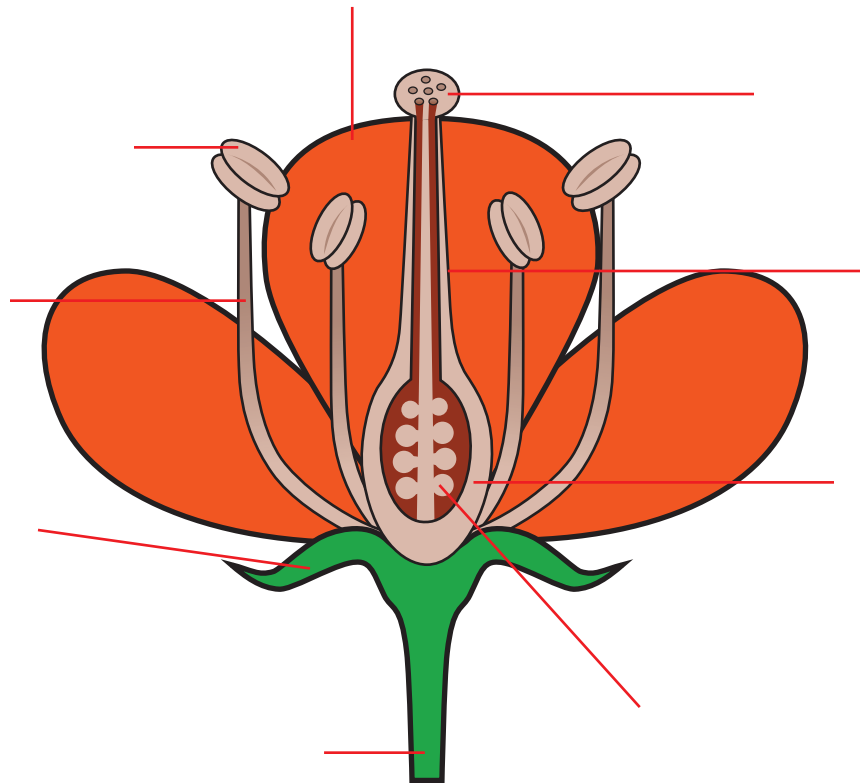
## Study Time!

Flowers are broadly divided into 5 parts – stamens, pistils, petals, sepals, and stalks. Stamens are further divided into anthers and filaments while pistils are divided into stigma, style, ovary, and ovules.
